Green Open Access – share your Accepted Manuscript ...

immediately

- For grant applications, thesis or doctorate
- Upon invitation only for research collaboration groups

after 12 months

- On Scholarly Collaboration Networks (SCNs) signed up to the STM Voluntary article sharing principles
- On not-for-profit hosting platforms such as your institutional repository

... as long as

- It is not altered or enhanced
- Please include a link to the final published version via its DOI along with the following text: „This is an Accepted Manuscript of an article published by Thieme Publishing Group in Journal Title on Publication Date, available online at <https://www.thieme-connect.de/products/ejournals/abstract/10.1055/article DOI>“
